Tall strong horse with a lot of scope; big mover, self-confident.

Smart performer with impressive action; Lightly raced from 3 to 6 years on distances between 1600-2600 metres (1 mile – 1m5f).

Prix Dollar (Gr.2), Longchamp, Prix Jean de Chaudenay (Gr.2), Saint-Cloud, Stockholm Cup International (Gr.3), Täby Sweden, Pokalløb (L), Klampenborg, Denmark (twice), Danish Jockey Club Cup (L), Klampenbrog, Denmark (twice), and placed 12 times, incl. 2<sup>nd</sup> in Scandinavian Open Championship (Gr.3), Klampenborg, Denmark, 3<sup>rd</sup> in Hong Kong Cup (Gr.1), Sha Tin, Stockholm Cup International (Gr.3), Täby, Sweden (twice), and Scandinavian Open Championship (Gr.3), Klampenborg, Denmark, 4<sup>th</sup> Grosser Preis von Europa (Gr.1), Cologne, Germany, and 5<sup>th</sup> in Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud (Gr.1), Sain-Cloud, France, all his starts.

Best performances at 2400 metres (12 furlongs), even won good races at shorter distances. See performance record.

Acts best on good/soft and good/firm ground. All his starts on turf, except Swedish Derby 1999 on dirt track (placed 2<sup>nd</sup>). Scandinavian jockeys for the first 19 races. Last two races Frederick Sanchez and Olivier Peslier, both from France.

DANO-MAST pulled off a shock win if his pari-mutuel price was anything to go by, and whilst this was a career-best effort, he was by no means a forlorn hope on earlier form which included a win on French soil in last year's Prix Jean de Chaudenay; well placed throughout, he was ridden along early in the straight and never looked in any danger after taking the lead 2f out; he's one of the best horses to come out of Scandinavia in recent years.
